



What is an Agoonoree?

A camp run by Scouts and Guides to which children with disabilities from the local community are invited.

How does the camp operate?

The camp is divided into 6 troops: 4 Scout Troops – Blue, Grey, Orange and Yellow; and 2 Guide Troops – Purple and Red.

Each Troop has 6 staff, including a Troop Leader, first aider, QM and assistants.

There are up to 6 patrols of Scouts or Guides in each Troop, with up to 6 Venturers or Older Guides, one to assist each Patrol.

Support staff includes the Camp Chief and assistants, the MASH team (qualified nursing staff), an on call doctor, Activity Coordinators and Activity Staff, Laundry Staff, Equipment Staff, Central QM, Central Camp Leaders and the Security Team.

How old to I need to be?

Venturers need to be 15 years old at the time of the camp.

What will I do?

Spend the week in Troop Lines or Central.

If you are in Troop Lines, your role is to assist a patrol in looking after 2 children with disabilities. Caring for the guests is part of the camp, and depending on their level of disability this can vary from feeding them to being a friend and reminding them of what they need to do. You will also assist your Troop Leader as required including setting up and pulling down camp.

If you are in central, you will be required to help prepare and run an activity base, assist at Bungalow, set up and pull down camp, help out services, and any other duties required by the activity leaders.

Where will I sleep?

In either Troop Lines or Activity Central, in a supplied dome tent.

What do I need?

Tenting, food and all activity equipment is supplied. You just need to bring clothing sufficient for a week, eating utensils, sleeping bag/blankets, air bed and any medication. A full list is supplied with the application.

What will it cost me?

Venturers and Ranger Guides \$80.00

Theme?

For 2004 will be – The Past, The Present and the Future.

Do I have to fill out any other forms?

Yes. Registration and Medical Forms will be sent to those selected from the expression of interest forms. Only a limited number of places are available. Preference will be given to early applicants.

Where is the Campsite?

Baden-Powell Park, Cash Ave, Samford.

When do I need to be there?

Venturers – from 9am Saturday 18th September to 2.30pm Friday 24th September, 2004.

What Happens Now?

Just after the closing date (31st July), all the forms will be assessed, and those applicants selected will be sent further information.

You will also need to make yourself available for a pre-Agoonoree Venturer Training camp on 28th–29th August, 2004. Further details will be mailed on the 31st of July, 2004
